In order to be considered for a scholarship, this application, an essay, and two letters of recommendation **must be mailed together**. Official school transcript may be mailed directly from the school or included with the application. Please submit only the information requested and **do not expand this application form onto additional pages**.

**All application information, including school transcript, must be postmarked no later than March 31, 2009.** Applications that are incomplete, not in accordance with the directions, or not postmarked by the above mentioned date will not be eligible. Please check the boxes below to ensure that you have collected all necessary information and your application is complete:

- An essay, limited to 1 page and font no less than 10 point.** Please address the following questions: What community or school service activity is most meaningful to you and why? What impact did your service have? Describe what you learned and how it affected you. Print your name at top of essay.
- Letter of recommendation from instructor or supervisor** (1 page only). No more than one year old.
- Letter of recommendation from someone affiliated with the activity described in your essay** (1 page only). No more than one year old.
- Official school transcript from most recent school attended.** The transcript must be sealed or otherwise official as defined by your school. Photocopies are not acceptable.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

Selection will be based on the following criteria and is limited to members of BECU:

- >> **Community/School Service**
- >> **Leadership Potential**
- >> **Academic Achievement**

At least twenty-five \$2500 scholarships will be awarded to graduating high school seniors and undergraduate students. Selection will be made without regard to the applicant's race, color, ethnic origin, religious belief, sex, marital status, or physical handicap.

## ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to apply for a BECU Foundation Scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

1. *You must be a member of BECU, primary account holder.\**
2. *You must be a graduating high school senior or undergraduate student. All scholarship recipients must attend college full time.*
3. *You must have a GPA of 3.0 or greater.*
4. *Award recipients must be able to provide verification of acceptance/enrollment in college.*
5. *BECU Foundation scholarships are non-renewable. Any previous scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply.*
6. *Relatives of any member of the BECU Foundation, the BECU Board of Directors, the BECU Supervisory Committee, the BECU Executive Management Team, or the BECU Scholarship Selection Committee are not eligible to apply.*

## WHO CAN BELONG TO BECU?\*

If you live, work, worship or attend school in a Washington state school district, you can be a BECU member. Or, if you are a past or present employee (or their family member) of: The Boeing Company, Boeing subsidiaries or affiliates, BECU or The Museum of Flight.

All persons who live, work, worship, or attend school within "qualified communities" defined as: all Washington State School Districts.

Note: BECU also serves Federal employees stationed at Boeing plants, and family members of any eligible employee.

\* To become a member of BECU, simply establish a BECU savings account with a deposit of at least \$5.
